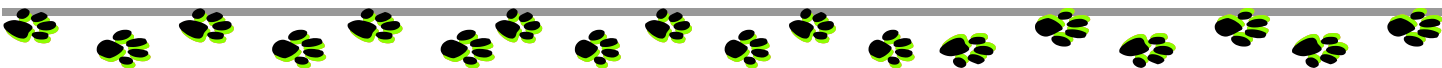

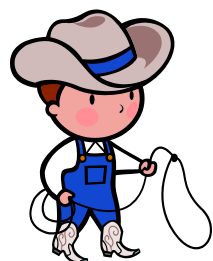


Dual Language
